## Skills set needed

Furthermore, you will need to be able to carry out the field trials work (due to the proportion of time required for this element of the role) and preferably have field trials experience or similar (although this is not essential).

Desirable, though not essential proficiencies include telehandler qualification, PA1, PA6 and PA2 pesticide application qualifications.

You will need to be able to effectively prioritise and carry out tasks, give attention to detail, meet deadlines and follow systems whilst running and monitoring first class field trials.
